Currently touring Australia, in their kombi van, full time for 11 months, before touring internationally to NZ, Japan and Canada.

Steve Tyson is best known as the guitarist and mandolin player in Rough Red, who toured Europe four times performing at many of the major summer festivals.

In recent years, he has also played in a blues/roots trio Twentysevens, which in between releasing three records, toured the UK supporting rock legends Status Quo on their 31 date Winter tour in 2006.

Steve is currently recording his first solo album. He describes the songs as "a journey through my musical subconscious", and reflections of his extensive travels throughout the world. In between performing acoustic and solo, Steve continues to gig with The Twentysevens and the recently reformed Rough Red.
